MISSION

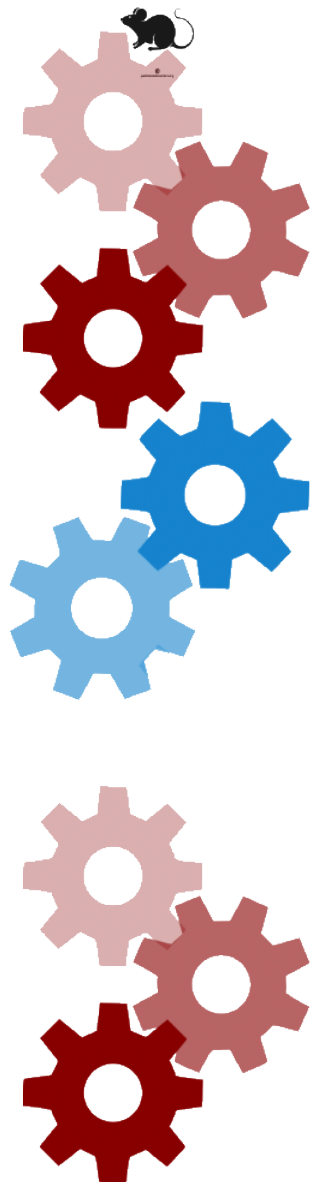
